Construction	2026	\$288,000,000

This project will improve capacity and mobility on I-95 from MM 8 to approximately MM 21 due to the projected increase in traffic demand and freight volumes. Operational and structural deficiencies on interchanges and bridges will also be addressed within the corridor.

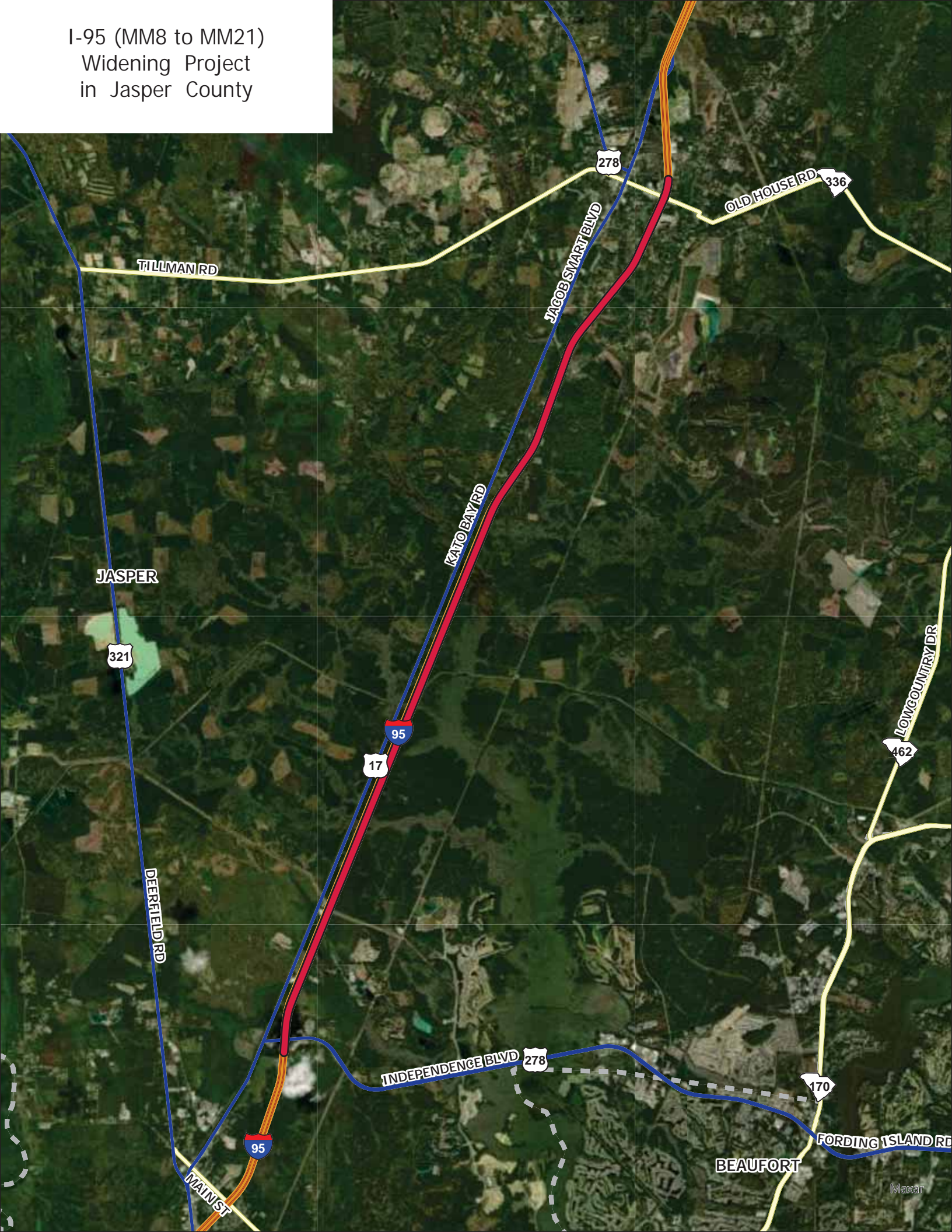

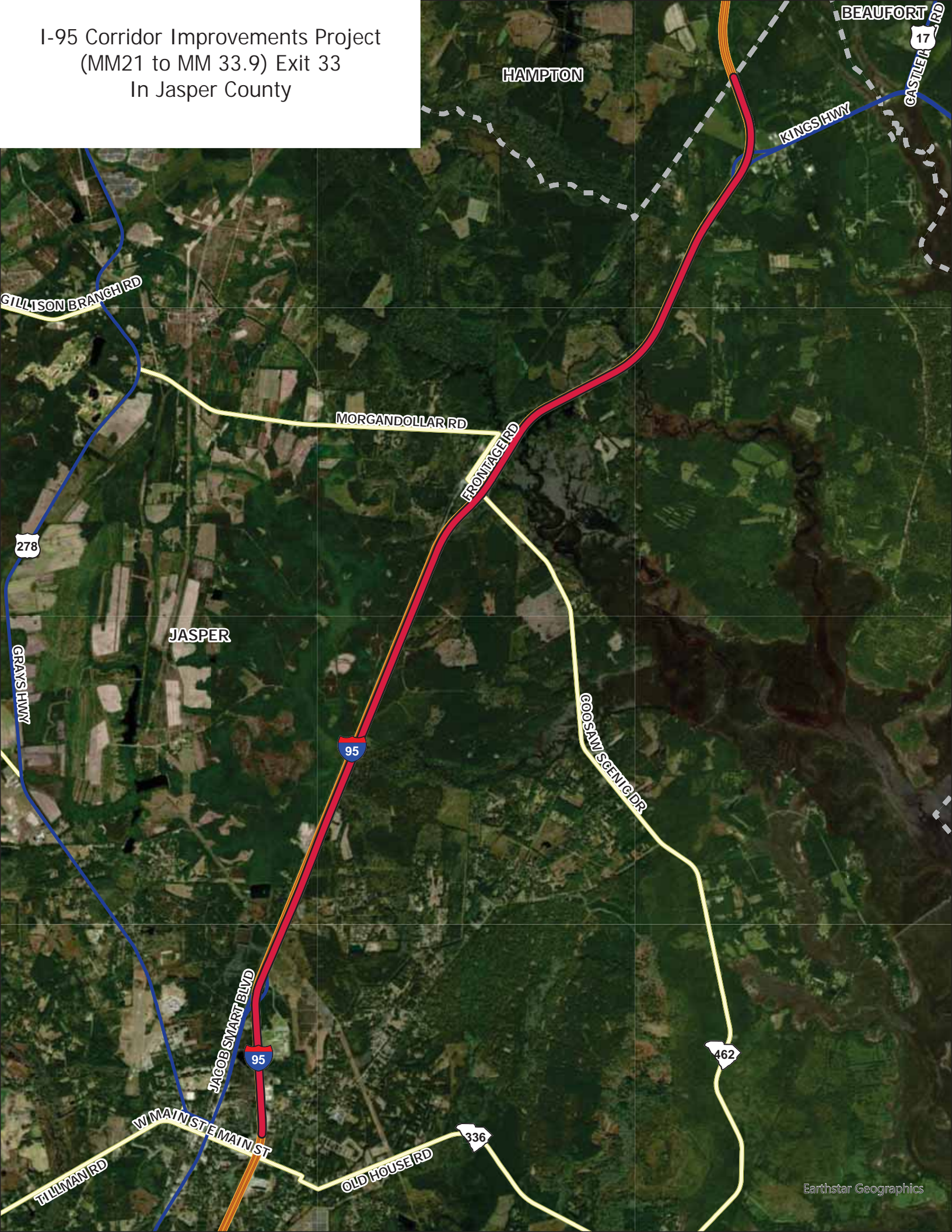

The project will remove a scour critical bridge and replace it with a new structure that meets current standards. This is a heavily traveled interstate that helps move the motoring public, services, and goods throughout the state.

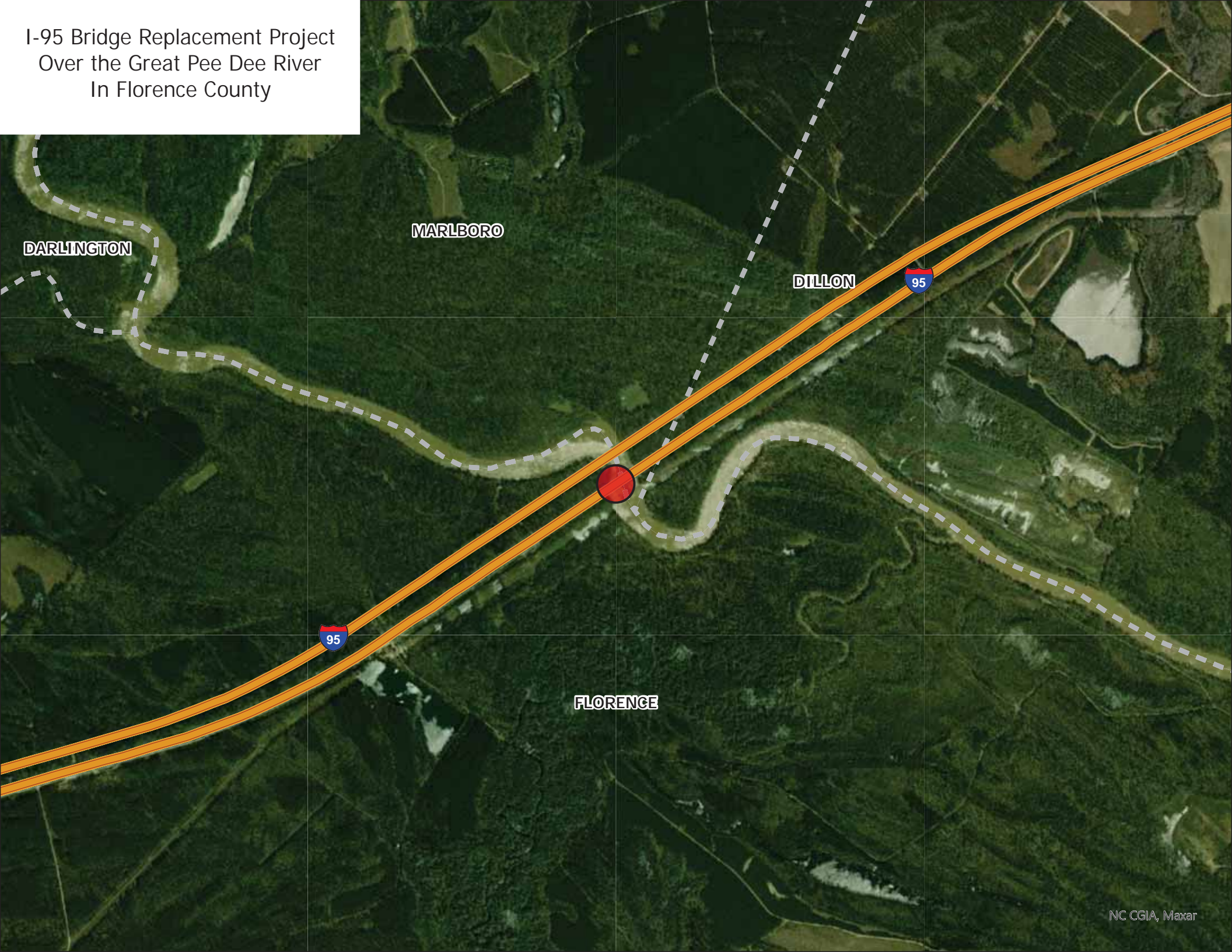
